



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Ham Road, Sidlesham CP, 29th June 2026.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Ham Road, Sidlesham CP, in the Chichester District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Ham Road for a distance approx 50 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 29th June 2026 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 3rd July 2026) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while AJS Groundworks undertakes 24hr/day road closures for ducting and irrigation works.

Road closed northbound at the junction with Easton Lane for 50 metres

The restriction will be in place **24hrs/day**

Access maintained for residents and pedestrians.

Emergency services access will not be maintained during works and the diversion route will need to be followed.
